



Using Studygram with Your Students

Created for Years 10-12; may be suitable for younger students with strong literacy skills and good self-awareness. Studygram is flexible and can be used in different ways depending on the time available in your timetable.

Flexible implementation options

OPTION 1

Self-paced at home

Students complete the diagnostic quiz at home and review their Studygram independently.

Best suited for: No class time available.

OPTION 2

Quiz at school, review at home

Students complete the diagnostic quiz during class time, then review their Studygram at home.

Best suited for: Limited class time.

OPTION 3

Use Studygram at school

Students complete the diagnostic quiz and complete review activities during class time.

Best suited for: A guided study skills, wellbeing, pastoral care or careers activity.

RECOMMENDED

One lesson per dimension for deeper review

Ideal scenario: allow at least 5 lessons for the review process, with one lesson focused on each Studygram dimension.

1

Review

Students: complete the review activities for one dimension.

2

Discuss

Move into same-profile groups and discuss what it means.

3

Share

Report back to the class key strengths, challenges and strategies.

4

Apply

Print the action plan and use the strategies for 1-2 weeks.

5

Debrief

In the next lesson, reflect with a partner before moving to the next dimension.

FAQ

How long does the diagnostic quiz take?

- The diagnostic quiz includes 8 sets of 10 questions, with short brain-break activities after each set.
- Many students complete the quiz in around 30 minutes, so it can usually be completed in one lesson.
- There is a short delay between questions to ensure students read the next question carefully before selecting their response.
- For students with lower literacy, focus difficulties or behavioural challenges, spread the quiz over shorter sittings: for example, 4 sets + 4 sets, or 1-2 sets per lesson.
- Student answers are saved automatically, so students can return later and continue from where they left off.

FAQ

How long does the Studygram review take?

- Some students may review all five dimensions in one lesson, but many benefit from 2-3 lessons to work through their Studygram more thoughtfully.
- Students can email the full PDF of their Studygram to their parents by selecting that option.
- Review responses are saved automatically and can be edited or updated at any time.
- Once students have fully reviewed their Studygram a certified badge appears on their dashboard.
- Regular revisiting helps students reflect on progress, refine strategies and build stronger self-awareness as learners.
